The purpose of this scholarship from the Laurel Art Club is to encourage additional studies in art for a promising senior art student from a local high school. Please look at these qualities when you are reviewing a portfolio.

1. **Basic skills**—Examples show understanding of drawing skills, use of media and communication.
2. **Creativity**—The selections show use of media in an appealing way.
3. **Originality**—The art uses the artist's own ideas and viewpoints.
4. **Neatness**—Samples are free of smudges, rips, stray marks, or dog ears.
5. **Diversity**—A variety of media, subject matter, and ideas are included
6. **Presentation**—Art is matted or framed in an appropriate way to show and preserve its beauty and includes at least one piece that is ready for the Fall Show.
7. **Knowledge**—All the pieces show correct use of media.
